DWR's RESPONSE IN OPPOSITION TO GMD2's MOTION TO COMPEL TO THE DIVISION OF WATER RESOURCES

COMES NOW the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Division of Water Resources (hereinafter "DWR"), by and through counsel, Aaron B. Oleen, and hereby opposes GMD2's Motion to Compel to the Division of Water Resources (the "Motion"). The Motion is blatantly improper given the extent to which DWR previously worked with GMD2 regarding discovery issues, and the length of time that GMD2 has allowed to pass in the interim before filing this Motion.

I. BACKGROUND

1. On November 9, 2018, GMD2 sent a "Golden Rule Letter" to DWR regarding certain alleged deficiencies with DWR's written discovery responses and productions to GMD2 (i.e., to GMD2's first request for admissions, first interrogatories, and first request for production of documents). (See Golden Rule Letter attached as Ex. C to the Motion, and DWR responses attached as Ex. A to the Motion; see also DWR's response and production to GMD2's first request for production of documents, attached as Exhibit A hereto, which GMD2 did not attach to its Motion.)

- DWR's counsel took the initiative to arrange a conference call between DWR and GMD2 to discuss the Golden Rule Letter, which conference call occurred on November 15, 2018. During that call, GMD2's counsel notified DWR that clarifying, additional written discovery was forthcoming and thus DWR could defer responding to the Golden Rule Letter until after DWR responded to such discovery. DWR later responded to that additional written discovery (a second request for admissions and second interrogatories) on the agreed deadline of December 21, 2018. (See letter from DWR to GMD2, dated December 28, 2018, attached as Exhibit B hereto; see also DWR responses attached as Ex. A to the Motion.)
- 3. On December 28, 2018, DWR sent its response letter to GMD2's Golden Rule Letter. (See Exhibit B hereto.) With its letter, DWR provided GMD2 with access to unredacted copies of many previously redacted or withheld discovery documents and also enclosed a revised privilege log. (See Exhibit B hereto.) GMD2 attached DWR's original privilege log as Exhibit B to its Motion, but GMD2 fails to acknowledge, attach, or specifically address the contents of, DWR's revised privilege log.

II. ARGUMENT

4. Since DWR sent its December 28, 2018 response letter to GMD2, DWR has heard nothing from GMD2 about any remaining discovery issues. In the more than two months that have elapsed since December 28, at no point has GMD2 reached out to DWR regarding the issues addressed in DWR's response letter or in any way indicated that GMD2 was unsatisfied with DWR's response. Rather, GMD2 obviously has chosen the litigation strategy of sandbagging DWR with a baseless discovery motion at the eleventh-hour motion-deadline and only two weeks before the formal-phase hearing in this matter. If GMD2 truly were concerned about any discovery issues involving DWR, GMD2 would have reached out to DWR weeks if not months ago.

- 5. GMD2 provides no basis for its claim that "DWR has still improperly withheld information from the District", and no explanation for its requests that all communications involving the Chief Engineer be unredacted and that DWR enumerate all *ex parte* communications involving the Chief Engineer and either DWR or Wichita. Such unsubstantiated claims and requests should not even merit a defense.
- 6. Nevertheless, the Presiding Officer should know that DWR has closely reviewed all documents that DWR originally withheld or redacted, and that DWR then chose to provide many items that it determined were less clearly subject to a privilege or protection or were not worth continuing to make such an assertion. (See Exhibit B hereto.) As indicated in DWR's revised privilege log, many of the redacted or withheld communications involve legal advice sought by the Chief Engineer and provided by his attorney, KDA's chief counsel. DWR is not in a position here to waive the attorney-client privilege of the Chief Engineer-Presiding Officer. Such a waiver of this and other asserted privileges and protections might properly be done by the Presiding Officer and KDA chief counsel following an *in camera* review of the disputed documents. DWR would not object to such a review. Notably, GMD2 has never requested it.
- 7. As to GMD2's request for an enumeration of all *ex parte* communications with the Chief Engineer, DWR has already provided GMD2 with a list of reasonably known communications and meetings that DWR or the Chief Engineer had with Wichita leading up to this matter. (*See* DWR's response to Interrogatory 9 of GMD2's first interrogatories, and related spreadsheet, attached as Ex. A to the Motion; *see also* DWR's responses to Interrogatories 3 and 4 of GMD2's second interrogatories, attached as Ex. A to the Motion.) GMD2 provides no basis in its Motion for GMD2's apparent assumption that *ex parte* communications between DWR or Wichita and the Presiding Officer have occurred since formal proceedings in this matter were

initiated. To the extent that GMD2's request regarding such communications is based on certain

claims or characterizations made in GMD2's pending Motion to Ensure Impartiality of Hearing

Officer, such request is unnecessary and improper for the reasons stated in DWR's response to such

motion, which are incorporated herein.

3. Given all of the above, GMD2's request for payment of attorney's fees associated

with its Motion is in particular bad form. Hopefully the gall in requesting fees as to issues not

discussed or pursued in over two months is evident. If anything, the bad faith necessary to support

an award of attorney's fees is present on the part of GMD2 in this matter. It certainly is not present

on the part of DWR.

WHEREFORE, DWR requests that GMD2's Motion be denied; and for such other and

further relief as the Presiding Officer deems just and equitable.

COMES NOW the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Division of Water Resources, and hereby provides responses to the First Request for Production of Documents propounded on DWR by Equus Beds Groundwater Management District Number 2 ("GMD2").

CERTAIN DEFINITIONS PROVIDED BY GMD2

- "You" and/or "Your" means the Kansas Department of Agriculture ("KDA") and/or the Division of Water Resources ("DWR"), and any agent, consultant, employee, or manager for KDA and/or DWR.
- 2. "Chief Engineer" means David Barfield, Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture.
- 3. "The District" shall mean the Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2.
- 4. "Subject Matter" means the content of this administrative hearing including, but not limited to, AMCs, the ASR Permit Modification Proposal, and all related subject matter.
- "ASR Permit Modification Proposal" means the proposal dated March 12, 2018, that the City submitted to the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture.

As used herein, the terms "identification," "identify," or "identity," when used in reference to (a) a natural individual, require you to state his or her full name, job title, residential and business addresses and home and business phone numbers; (b) a corporation or business, require you to state its full name and any names under which it does business, the address of its principal place of business, and the addresses of all of its offices; (c) a document, requires you to state the number of pages and the nature of the document (e.g., letter or memorandum), its title, its date, the name or names of its authors and recipients, and its present location and custodian; (d) a communication, requires you to identify the document or documents which refer to or evidence the communication; and (e) an oral communication, requires you to identify the persons participating in the communication and to state the date, manner, place and substance of the communication.
- 14. When a request requires you to "state the basis of" a particular claim, defense, contention, or allegation, state in your answer the identity of each and every communication and each and every fact and legal theory that you think supports, refers to, or evidences such claim, defense, contention or allegation.
- 15. As used herein, the word "or" appearing in a request should not be read so as to eliminate any part of the request, but, whenever applicable, it should have the same meaning as the word "and."
- 16. As used herein, the words "person" or "entity" mean any natural person, company, business, partnership, corporation, association or other group carrying on a business enterprise.

Gentlemen,

This letter responds to GMD2's above-referenced "Golden Rule Letter" regarding DWR's October 30 and 31, 2018, responses to GMD2's first written-discovery requests to DWR. As you know, after GMD2 sent the Golden Rule Letter to DWR on November 9, 2018, the parties discussed it at a conference call on November 15, 2018. During that call, GMD2's counsel notified DWR that additional/clarifying written discovery was forthcoming and thus DWR could defer responding to the Golden Rule Letter until after such discovery was propounded and answered. DWR answered that discovery on the agreed extended deadline of December 21, 2018.

The following responses track the numbered paragraphs in GMD2's Golden Rule Letter.

Regarding paras. 1-5:

DWR's counsel have reviewed and reconsidered DWR's privilege log and the items listen therein that were redacted or withdrawn. Although we believe that most, if not all, of the assertions were properly made, we conclude that, in many instances, maintaining those assertions is not worth the apparent worry that results to GMD2 or its counsel. Accordingly, see DWR's enclosed, revised privilege log. As its key explains, additional detail or explanation is in italics and documents previously redacted or withheld but now produced are shaded in gray and are available in a new subfolder in DWR's shared OneDrive folder for this matter, available here: https://sokansas-

my.sharepoint.com/:f:/g/personal/aaron_oleen_kda_ks_gov/EhMJSDAipvVKhzTUayoL54UBNGdszUrD7JoK 50lV7CPTGw?e=lBFszw.

Furthermore, as to para. 3: DWR will not make a blanket production of all relevant documents that David Barfield sent or received. Mr. Barfield's role has only recently gone beyond that of Chief Engineer, to now also include Presiding Officer of this matter. This role change does not negate proper privileges or protections that applied to documents that Mr. Barfield sent or received when his role was merely that of Chief Engineer.

Regarding para. 6:

DWR did not intentionally provide evasive answers to GMD2's first written discovery to DWR. Such discovery questions often included incorrect assumptions, imprecise/ambiguous terminology, or compound concepts that made it difficult for DWR to ascertain GMD2's intent and answer the questions. DWR did its best, as DWR also has done in answering GMD2's clarifying second written discovery to DWR. Hopefully those answers render moot para. 6 of the Golden Rule Letter.

Regarding para. 7:

Though it may be standard to request the identification of "all documents that are relevant" or "all documents that relate to" something, it is also standard—and appropriate—to object to such requests as being overly broad and unduly burdensome. Relevance is a subjective and relative concept, and DWR does not know whether what GMD2 thinks is relevant is the same as what DWR thinks is relevant. That said, DWR does not believe that it has intentionally withheld materially relevant documents that are not identified on its revised privilege log. DWR is aware of its ongoing obligation to supplement its discovery responses and DWR will do so, as necessary and appropriate.

Regarding para. 8:

DWR's interrogatory answers were not improper—see the discussion above regarding para. 6 of GMD2's Golden Rule Letter. Hopefully the concern regarding this para. 8 likewise has been negated given DWR's responses to GMD2's clarifying second written discovery to DWR.

Regarding para. 9:

DWR's answer to GMD2's first interrogatory no. 22 was not "completely evasive"—it just apparently was not the answer that GMD2 wanted to hear. DWR answered truthfully and with a reasonable amount of explanation.

Regarding para. 10:

DWR did not intentionally produce responsive documents in an unorganized manner. Had DWR more time and resources, it likely would have attempted to Bates-label and better organize its production. But given DWR's available resources, the breadth of GMD2's document requests, and the long history and number of documents that had been generated regarding the Wichita ASR project, DWR made the best production that it could under the circumstances and in the available time. DWR's counsel is willing to help GMD2's counsel locate particular documents, if GMD2's counsel believes they exist and has not found them in DWR's production.
