



Mobile Food Unit Licensing Guide

The Kansas Department of Agriculture is devoted to the total support of agriculture in Kansas. While we must fulfill our statutory obligations, the department is dedicated to providing support and assistance to make Kansas farms, ranches and agribusinesses successful and help them grow if that is their desire. We also encourage more farms, ranches and other agriculture business to expand in or relocate to Kansas. This checklist will help guide you through various resources and requirements for opening and operating a typical Kansas mobile food unit. In addition to license requirements by the Kansas Department of Agriculture, other Kansas agencies as well as local or federal government agencies may have regulatory requirements to follow. Contact your local planning authority to ensure you follow all local business development laws, rules, regulations and guidelines. This guide is designed to assist you as you work to build and operate a successful mobile food unit in Kansas.

	Department of Agriculture, Food Safety & Lodging	Mobile food units must complete the Food Establishment License application, along with submitting the Mobile Unit Log . Contact Food Safety and Lodging at 785-564-6767 or FSL@kda.ks.gov for more information.	Prior to opening, April 1
	Department of Agriculture, Weights and Measures	No license is needed from Weights and Measures, but a mobile food unit with scales must hire a licensed service company to test the scales once annually if the scales are utilized for any commercial transaction. Visit the Weights & Measures website for more information, or call 785-564-6681.	Annual service
	Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC)	Vehicles over 10,000 pounds may be subject to certain safety regulations. Review the Procedures for Safety Compliance for a comprehensive list of requirements. Visit the KCC Transportation Division website, or call 785-271-3145 for more information.	Prior to operating the vehicle
