DWR opposes consideration of GMD2's revised summary-judgment motion and agrees that it should be stricken from the record. Even if such a filing has not expressly been prohibited by order of the Presiding Officer, such a prohibition is implicit in the parties' logistical discussions since the 7/24/19 *Order on Prehearing Motions* and such a prohibition has been effectively acceded to by GMD2, as DWR believes the recordings of subsequent hearings will support.

The proper procedure would have been for GMD2 to file a motion to allow consideration of such a revised dispositive motion. Regardless, DWR believes any revised dispositive motions are improper at this stage and should not be included in the record.
