NOTICE OF HEARING


Now on this 8th day of October 2019, the following date, time and parameters are set for an administrative hearing in the above-captioned matter.

This hearing will address the City of Wichita's proposed changes to the City of Wichita's Aquifer Storage and Recovery Project Phase II. The City is seeking the approval of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture for these changes.

The hearing will commence on December 10, 2019, at 9:00 a.m., at the First Mennonite Church, 427 W. 4th, Halstead, Kansas 67056. The formal phase of the hearing will be open to the public and will be scheduled to take place over three days, December 10, 11, and 12, 2019, beginning at 9:00 a.m. each day and ending no later than 5:00 p.m. each day. The public and all interested parties are invited to submit oral or written comments during a time specifically reserved for this purpose: oral public comments will be received beginning at 9:00 a.m. and ending no later than 11:00 a.m. on Friday, December 13, 2019, at the same location as the formal phase of the hearing, the First Mennonite Church, 427 W. 4th, Halstead, Kansas 67056.

Written comments will be accepted until the record is closed, which will occur at midnight on Friday, January 17, 2020, unless extended by further order. Written comments may be submitted any of the following ways: (1) by submitting them to Division of Water Resources staff during the formal phase of the hearing; (2) by submitting them to DWR staff or the presiding officer during the public comment phase of the hearing; (3) by mailing a copy to Ronda Hutton, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas, 66502, Attn: Wichita ASR Project Testimony; or (4) by sending an electronic copy via email to ronda.hutton@ks.gov.
