Kansas Egg Law

Pursuant to K.S.A. 74-120 and Executive Order 18-13, the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Food Safety and Lodging Program provides the following information pertaining to specific civil and criminal records that could disqualify an applicant from receiving a license, certification, registration or permit issued by the Department.

The Kansas Egg Law, specifically K.S.A. 2-2512, authorizes the Secretary to deny, suspend, revoke or modify any license issued by the Department pursuant to the Act. The list below identifies various violations which may result in the denial of any license issued by the Department. License categories that are subject to the list below include the following: egg license.

With respect to felony convictions or convictions of violations of the Kansas Egg Law, an investigation to determine if a person has been sufficiently rehabilitated to warrant the public trust will be conducted. If you have questions regarding licensure, you should review the Kansas Egg Law, K.S.A. 2-2501 *et seq.* or contact the Food Safety and Lodging Program.

Additionally, you may contact the Kansas Department of Agriculture and petition for an informal written advisory opinion concerning whether your civil or criminal records will disqualify you from receiving a license, certification, registration or permit.
