Agricultural Chemical Act of 1947

Pursuant to K.S.A. 74-120 and Executive Order 18-13, the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Pesticide and Fertilizer Program provides the following information pertaining to specific civil and criminal records that could disqualify an applicant from receiving a license, certification, registration or permit issued by the Department.

The Agricultural Chemical Act of 1947, specifically K.S.A. 2-2204, provides that the Secretary may deny registration of a product.

If you have questions regarding licensure, you should review the Agricultural Chemical Act of 1947, K.S.A. 2-2201 *et seq.* or contact the Pesticide and Fertilizer Program.

Additionally, you may contact the Kansas Department of Agriculture and petition for an informal written advisory opinion concerning whether your civil or criminal records will disqualify you from receiving a license, certification, registration or permit.
