Kansas Fertilizer Law

Pursuant to K.S.A. 74-120 and Executive Order 18-13, the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Pesticide and Fertilizer Program provides the following information pertaining to specific civil and criminal records that could disqualify an applicant from receiving a license, certification, registration or permit issued by the Department.

The Kansas Fertilizer Law, specifically K.S.A. 2-1201c, authorizes the Secretary to deny, suspend or revoke any ammonium nitrate dealer registration issued by the Department pursuant to the Act. The list below identifies various violations which may result in the denial of any ammonium nitrate dealer registration issued by the Department.

If you have questions regarding licensure, you should review the Kansas Fertilizer Law, K.S.A. 2-1201 *et seq.* or contact the Pesticide and Fertilizer Program.

Additionally, you may contact the Kansas Department of Agriculture and petition for an informal written advisory opinion concerning whether your civil or criminal records will disqualify you from receiving a license, certification, registration or permit.
