Scales and Dispensing Devices

Pursuant to K.S.A. 74-120 and Executive Order 18-13, the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Weights and Measures Program provides the following information pertaining to specific civil and criminal records that could disqualify an applicant from receiving a license, certification, registration or permit issued by the Department.

K.S.A. 83-308 and K.S.A. 83-407, authorizes the Secretary to revoke, suspend, decline to renew or issue any license issued by the Department pursuant to the Act. The list below identifies various violations which may result in the denial of any license issued by the Department. License categories that are subject to the list below include the following: service company license or technical representative's license.

If you have questions regarding licensure, you should review the Kansas law, relating to scales and dispensing devices in chapter 83 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated or contact the Weights and Measures Program.

Additionally, you may contact the Kansas Department of Agriculture and petition for an informal written advisory opinion concerning whether your civil or criminal records will disqualify you from receiving a license, certification, registration or permit. See the Petition for Informal Advisory Opinion page for instructions on how to petition the Kansas Department of Agriculture for an informal written advisory opinion.

Violation

Refusal to provide the Secretary with reasonably complete and accurate information regarding methods used, materials used or work performed

Failure to comply with any provision or requirement of chapter 83 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, or any rule and regulation adopted thereunder

Failure to perform work in a manner consistent with the standards set forth in chapter 83 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, or rules and regulations adopted thereunder

Commission of an unlawful act as established in K.S.A. 83-219, and amendments thereto or any rules and regulations adopted thereunder
