

**IN THE MATTER OF THE CITY OF WICHITA'S PHASE II AQUIFER STORAGE AND RECOVER PROJECT IN HARVEY AND SEDGWICK COUNTIES, KANSAS**, the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, previously announced that a public hearing concerning proposed changes and additions to the City of Wichita's project was scheduled to be held on October 22, 2018. That public hearing **IS POSTPONED UNTIL DECEMBER 11, 2018**. The City of Wichita has withdrawn several applications that were to be considered and therefore the scope of the hearing has been narrowed and will only consider the other proposed changes to the existing project.

The hearing will commence on December 11, 2018 at 9:00 a.m., at American Ag Credit, 4105 N. Ridge Rd., Wichita, Kansas 67205. If the hearing cannot be completed in one day, the proceedings will continue at 9:00 a.m. on December 12, 2018, at the same location. The public and all interested parties are encouraged to submit oral comments at the hearing or written comments prior to 5:00 p.m. on January 11, 2019.
