Discussion Topics

1. It was asked if recent flood mitigation improvements, such as newly constructed dams were included in the modeling.
 - a. These structures will need to be evaluated further.
2. Some mitigation efforts have been done in Fort Scott. Are those being represented?
 - a. It is recognized that the BLE data doesn't account for city storm water infrastructure.
 - b. There was some interest in potentially updating the regulatory floodplains in Fort Scott since improvements have been made recently to their infrastructure.
3. Concerns that the Mound City flooding is too large. The Mound City drainage area is a good candidate for enhanced hydrology through an HMS Model.
 - a. It was noted that there was no recent memory of any flooding on the fairgrounds.

Action Items

1. Mound City can look to provide the As-Built associated with the newly constructed Dollar General. Since much of that area is proposed to be added to the floodplain, it may not have needed a DWR fill permit at the time of construction.
2. KDA will send out the link to the [Base Flood Elevation Portal](#) for use as best available data for possible LOMAs in Zone A floodplains where the floodplain is decreasing.
