

OSAGE CUSTOM WATERSHED DISCOVERY REVIEW MEETING NOTES

Discussion Topics

1. Mound City has the survey information for the Dollar General that was built in Mound City after the LiDAR was collected. Pam Cannon will scan and send those files to KDA.
2. Oblique imagery is available for Linn County. Pam Cannon will send the login information.
3. There were discussions about a neighborhood in Mound City where the Changes Since Last FIRM (CSLF) did not appear to match up well with the actual terrain of the area. It may be due to the shore-lining process in the modeling. Wood will review this and a comment was left on the web map.
4. There was a discussion on how the culverts have been replaced on State Hwy 31, which alleviated flooding for one area, but may be pushing the flooding downstream.
5. Concerns were discussed about the wastewater treatment plant discharge and possible erosion on a property. The models might be of use to analyze the flows in that area. This led to the general discussion on how lagoons are to be handled in the 100-year floodplain. A comment was placed on the web map. The ponding areas will need to be shown in the floodplain, but if the lagoon walls are above the Base Flood Elevation (BFE) they will still be shown as out.

Action Items

1. KDA will send out the link to the [Base Flood Elevation Portal](#) for use as best available data for possible LOMAs in Zone A floodplains where the floodplain is decreasing.
