

Dickinson County Floodplain Mapping Open House Public Information Sheet December 6, 2018

General Information

Thank you for taking the time to understand floodplain mapping changes that are underway in Dickinson County and how those changes affect you. It is important to note that this mapping is not yet regulatory but in some cases may be usable as best available data. The mapping is currently in Draft, and we anticipate issuing Preliminary maps around April 2019. While the maps are in Draft, an informal public comment period has been initiated. Please submit any comments to your Floodplain Administrator or the State Floodplain Mapping Coordinator (flip sheet over for contact information) by **January 11, 2019**. Your community will then compile these comments and send them to the State for review.

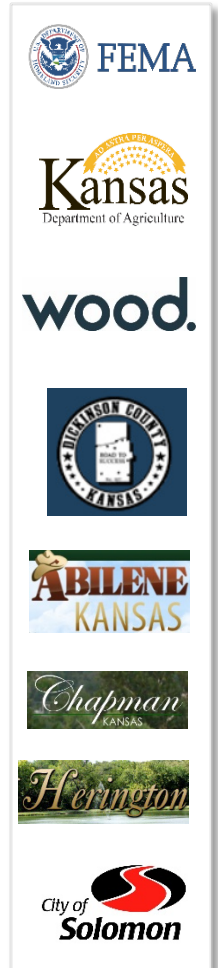
