CORRECTIONAL ORDER

IN THE MATTER OF THE PROPOSED DESIGNATION OF AN  
INTENSIVE GROUNDWATER USE CONTROL AREA IN THE  
VICINITY OF BURRTON, KANSAS

The Chief Engineer-Director, Division of Water Resources, Kansas State Board of Agriculture, (hereinafter referred to as the "Chief Engineer") after due consideration makes the following Findings and Order.

FINDINGS

1. That on June 1, 1984, the Chief Engineer issued an order establishing an Intensive Groundwater Use Control Area consisting of approximately 36 square miles in Harvey and Reno Counties generally located in the vicinity of Burrton, Kansas.
2. By letter dated June 22, 1984, a copy of this order was forwarded to water right holders of record in the control area. The letter pointed out that pursuant to Paragraph No. 2(c) of that Order, flow meters were required to be installed on all existing non-temporary and non-domestic well or wells within the control area. The letter stated that meters were to be installed on or before August 15, 1984.
3. That Paragraph No. 2(c) of the Order of the Chief Engineer enclosed with the June 22, 1984, letter provided that the flow meters were to be installed on or before July 15, 1984.
4. That therefore Paragraph 2(c) of the Order of the Chief Engineer, dated June 1, 1984, should be amended to read as follows:


ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, It is the decision and order of the Chief Engineer-Director, Division of Water Resources, Kansas State Board of Agriculture, that Paragraph No. 2(c) of Order dated June 1, 1984, establishing the Intensive Groundwater Use Control Area in the vicinity of Burrton, Kansas, shall be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

"That by August 15, 1984, or within any authorized extension of time therefore for good cause shown by the water user, flow meters shall be installed on all water wells now existing in the intensive groundwater use control area except on those wells used solely for domestic purposes and those wells authorized by temporary permits...(No amendment in remainder of Paragraph)."

That further the remainder of the Order of the Chief Engineer dated June 1, 1984, shall remain as set forth in the Order of the Chief Engineer dated June 1, 1984.


