Reference is made to the Amended Rules and Regulations governing the rotation, diversion and use of water for irrigation purposes from the Arkansas River by irrigation companies in Hamilton, Kearny and Finney Counties, Kansas, which Amended Rules and Regulations were first adopted and promulgated by the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources of the State Board of Agriculture by his Order made on May 12, 1961 and subsequently continued by his Orders made on January 16, 1962, February 26, 1963, March 31, 1964, March 4, 1965, February 23, 1966, March 27, 1967, April 1, 1968, April 1, 1969, March 26, 1970, March 15, 1971, March 6, 1972, March 20, 1973 April 9, 1974 and March 24, 1976.

I have today entered my Order continuing the same Amended Rules and Regulations to be in force and effect from April 1, 1976 to October 31, 1976. There are transmitted herewith to each of you signed copies of the Order.

## ORDER

On this 22nd day of March 1976, Guy E. Gibson, the duly appointed and acting Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources of the State Board of Agriculture, in the exercise of authority pursuant to KSA 82a-706a and pursuant to the Order made by the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources of the State Board of Agriculture on May 12, 1961, adopting and promulgating certain Amended Rules and Regulations governing the rotation, diversion and use of water for irrigation purposes from the Arkansas River by irrigation companies in Hamilton, Kearny and Finney Counties, Kansas, as set forth in said Order and approved by the State Board of Agriculture on August 22, 1961, does hereby continue said Amended Rules and Regulations to be in force and effect April 1, 1976, first for a period ending October 31, 1976 and thereafter by further Order of the Chief Engineer, continuing or amending the same as may be deemed necessary.
