ASSOCIATED DITCHES

RESOLUTION of January 27, 1982

WHEREAS, a Resolution adopted by the Arkansas River Compact Administration on April 24, 1980, concerning operation of John Martin Reservoir provides that Kansas may demand the release of water contained in the Kansas accounts at whatever time and rate they desire during the period of April 1 through October 31 of each year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that in order to demand water at least 50% of the ditch officials have to be in favor of requesting the release of water in storage from the John Martin Reservoir. The request for the release of water is to be made by each ditch official directly to the Division of Water Resources in Garden City, Kansas.

This Resolution to be effective April 1, 1982 and to continue in force until such time the Associated Ditches notifies the Division of Water Resources by written letter stating that they wish to discontinue this agreement.
