**Hemp Producers (Growers)**

Persons seeking to cultivate or produce industrial hemp must be licensed by the Kansas Department of Agriculture (KDA) as a commercial industrial hemp producer pursuant to K.S.A. 2-3901 *et seq.* As a reminder, hemp producer licenses expire annually on December 31. **The application deadline for the 2023 growing season is March 15, 2023.**
