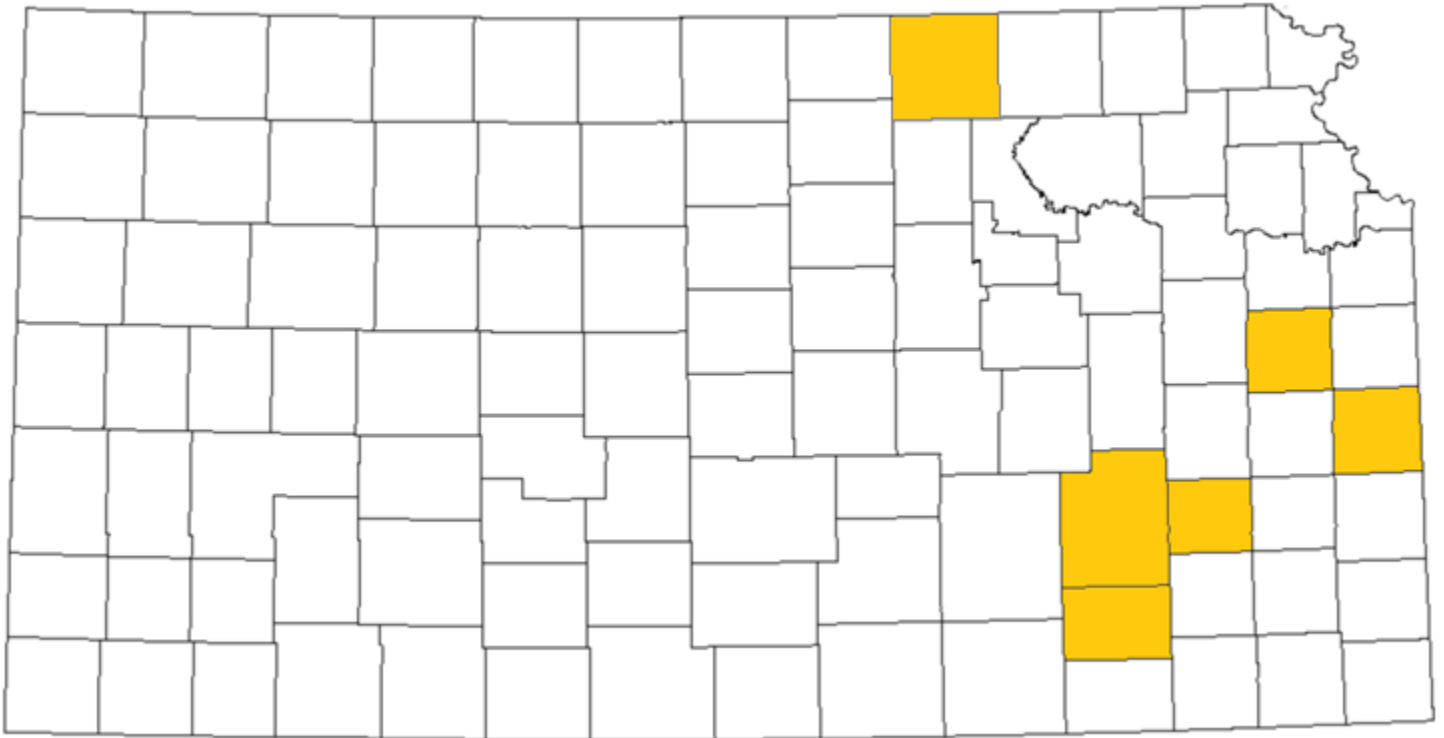


County Option Noxious Weeds

The Kansas Noxious Weed Act allows for counties to declare, with approval of the Secretary of Agriculture, species of plants to be noxious in their county (K.S.A. 2-1314).
