Notable AFI Activities

April: AFI attended the Pet Professionals Seminar in Topeka.

May: Investigator Brethauer assisted the Montgomery County Sheriffs Office with the seizure of 16 dogs, 4 cats, 16 rabbits, 13 chickens, 16 ducks, 1 lizard, 2 snakes, and 2 birds from a home where they were living in deplorable conditions.

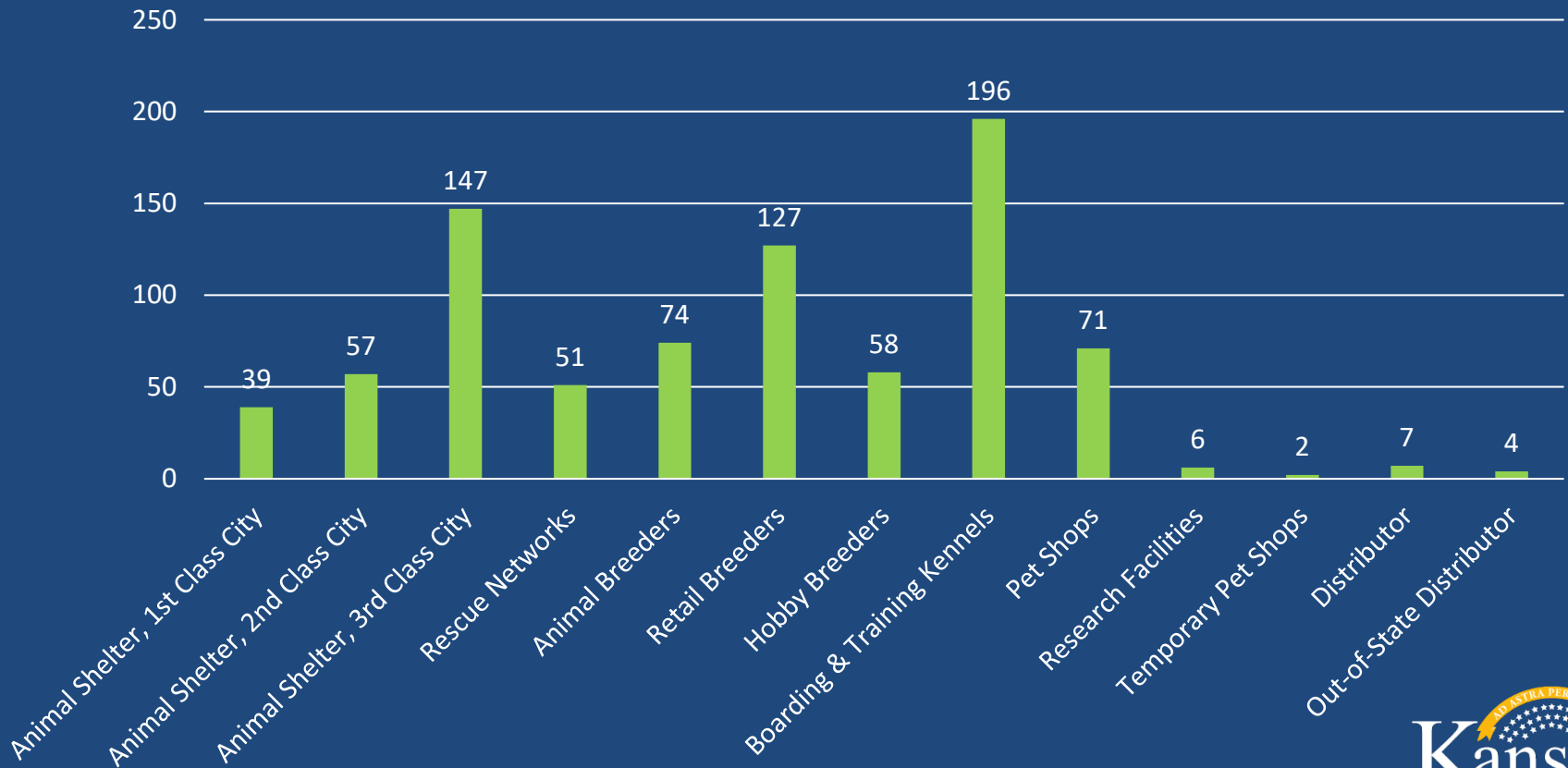

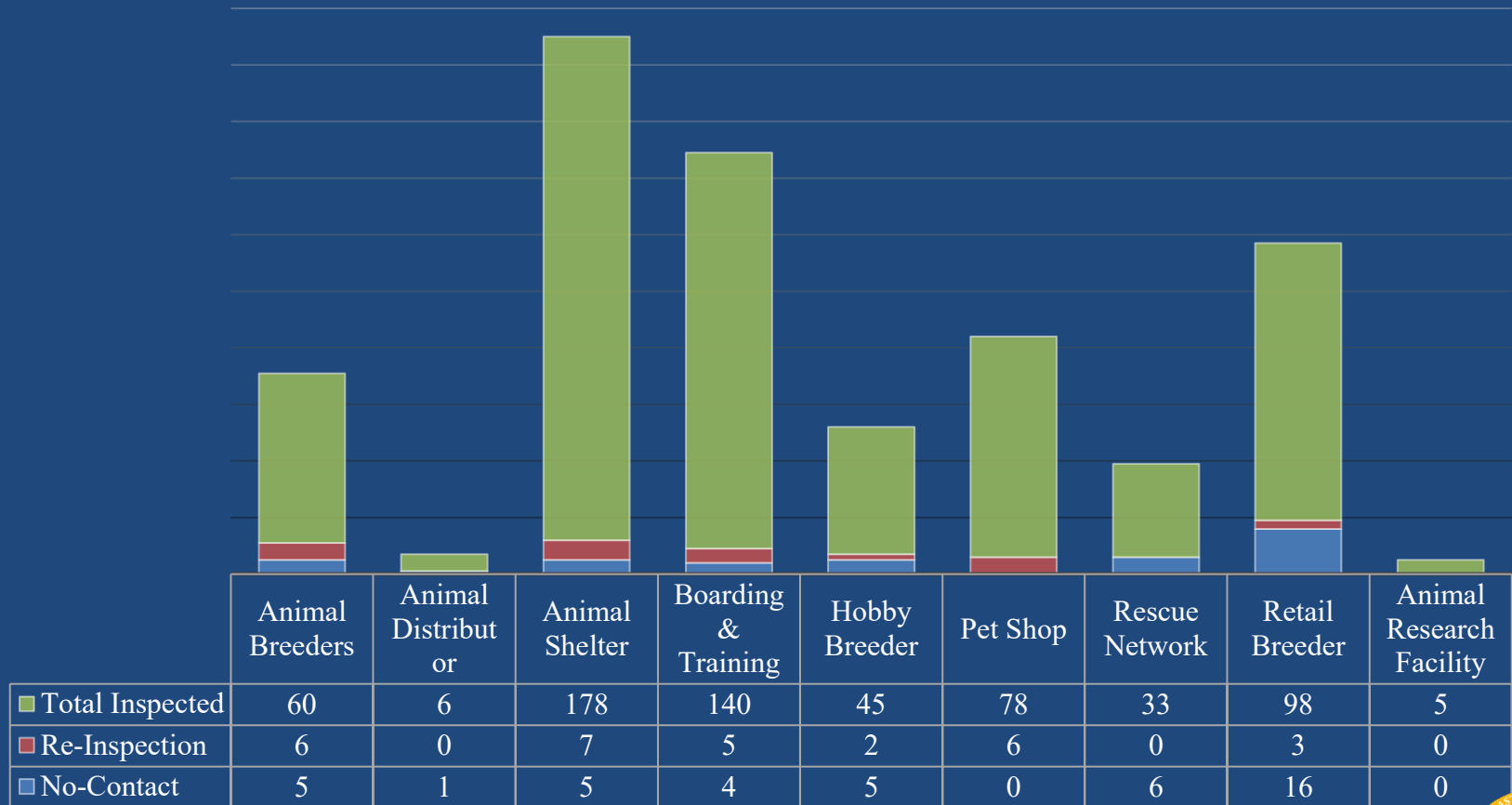

Enforcement

- December 7, 2022 – June 16, 2023 Orders
 - AFI Orders issued
 - 2 Revocation of License with Civil Penalty Orders
 - 2 Cease and Desist with Civil Penalty Orders
 - 10 Civil Penalty Orders
 - 4 License Revocation
- Judicial Review case pending in Cowley County District Court
- Two cases are pending at OAH (both Revocation of License with Civil Penalty Orders)
- Lawsuit against KDA alleging inspection process violates 4th amendment protections and no-contact fee is unlawful was dismissed but is being appealed.
