Go to step #3.



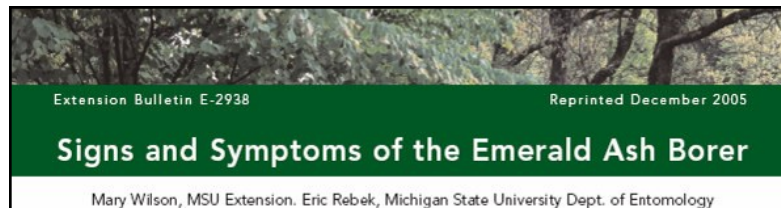
2) I suspect I have seen an emerald ash borer.  
Go to step #5.



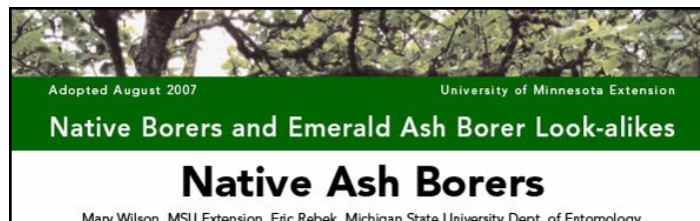
