## Female Cattle Status Affidavit for Interstate Movement Purposes

In order for female cattle to be imported into Kansas for any purposes other than slaughter or feeding, they must meet one of the criteria outlined in K.A.R. 9-7-4a.

I declare the female cattle I am presenting for sale on the above date will meet at least one of the following requirements, or will be sold for feeding or slaughter purposes only.

*Please check all that apply*

- Have a calf at side and no exposure since parturition to bulls other than certified negative *Tritrichomonas foetus* bulls
- Are at least 120 days pregnant
- Are virgin heifers with no sexual exposure to bulls since weaning
- Have had at least 120 days of sexual isolation
- Are heifers or cows exposed only to certified negative *Tritrichomonas foetus* bulls
- Are moving for embryo transfer or other artificial reproduction procedure with no exposure to bulls after entering Kansas
