Guest Safety



SMOKE DETECTORS

- All guest rooms are required to have functional smoke detectors to protect guests against fire and smokerelated injury or death.
- Smoke detectors for hearing impaired individuals must be available for rooms that don't open directly to out of doors on ground floors (1 per 50 rooms).
- All fire alarm and sprinkler systems must be tested and approved annually.

CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS

- Carbon monoxide detectors in good working order are required in the following areas:
 - o Fuel-fired equipment (gas water heaters, gas dryers, etc.)
 - Non-guest rooms adjoining or sharing common ventilation systems with an attached parking garage
 - Rooms with wood-burning fireplaces

Smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors must be tested every six months. Keep a 12-month history on file and available for review.

EXIT SIGNS

- Must be provided and maintained in a clean and legible condition visible from:
 - o Guest rooms that open to an interior corridor; and
 - o Guest rooms that open to the outside, but not directly at ground level.

An evacuation route diagram must be posted in each guest room or immediately adjacent to each guest room door.

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
