FECAL AND VOMIT ACCIDENT REPORT SWIMMING POOLS, HOT TUBS, AND OTHER WATER FEATURES

In response to any accident involving formed feces, diarrhea, vomiting, body fluid spills, etc., the following requirements shall be met: Direct guests to leave the swimming pool, hot tub, or other water feature, and do not allow any individuals to reenter until the decontamination process has been completed. This process is listed in section 28-36-84 of the state lodging regulations. This report must be completed in full and must be maintained on site with the daily records for the facility for a period of at least one year.
